Jimmie Leppink is an Assistant Professor of Methodology and Statistics and Data Manager at the School of Health Professions Education, Maastricht University. He has a background in Psychology (MSc), Forensics and Law (LLM), Methodology and Statistics (MSc), and Education (PhD). His research, consultancy and teaching activities focus on best practices of methodology and statistics in education research, adaptive approaches to learning and assessment as well as legislative and methodological principles of good data management practice. These areas of focus unite in the use of learning process and outcome measures, also known as learning analytics, to inform learning and assessment in online learning environments. He has been the Statistical Editor for the journal *Perspectives on Medical Education* (January 2014 – September 2018), a Statistical Advisor for the journal *BioMed Central (BMC) Medical Education* (since August 2016), and a Senior Editor for the journal *Health Professions Education* (since April 2018). He is also the founder and one of the managers of the LinkedIn discussion group *Research, Methodology, and Statistics in the Social Sciences*, which currently hosts over 130,000 members from across the world.
