Professor Gabriel Reedy - Keynote Workshop Summary

Title: Shaping your Research for Publication: Honing your Message and Refining your Manuscript

The pressure to publish is ubiquitous in academia, and getting your work published in the academic literature can be a painful and dispiriting process. It can feel like the old ground rules are changing and the standards keep increasing: what would have been easily published ten years ago is often rejected as no longer publishable. One of the primary ways we train academics at doctoral level is to model new studies after what is already published in the scientific literature, which can be problematic. Further, many of us in health professions education may consider ourselves clinicians, educators, or scientists first, rather than writers, making the task feel even more daunting. Building on the experience of an academic journal editor-in-chief, this workshop will help colleagues to bring together their own experiences, feedback, tips, and guiding principles for working through the challenging process of getting their work published in the academic literature.
