Professor Janet Anderson – Keynote Speaker

Janet Anderson's disciplinary background is Psychology. She holds Bachelor of Behavioural Science and Master of Psychology degrees from La Trobe University and received her PhD from the Key Centre for Human Factors and Applied Cognitive Psychology at the University of Queensland in 2004.

Janet has recently resettled in Melbourne after many years in the UK and is now Professor of Human Factors in the Department of Anaesthesiology and Perioperative Medicine at Monash University. She has held various academic positions in the UK including 12 years at King's College London where she led research into patient safety and quality improvement in partnership with several large London hospitals. She also established the Centre for Applied Resilience in Healthcare (CARE) which has developed tools and methods for quality improvement based on insights from Resilient Healthcare. Her main research interests are in interprofessional teamwork and leadership, clinical education and simulation, and designing systems to support human performance in complex adaptive systems.
